

MIDTOWN BAG CLASS

Supply list

Sewing Machine in good working order

Pins and Wonder clips (optional but very helpful)

Scissors

Seam ripper

80/12 or 90/14 quilting, sharp or denim needle

Rotary cutter, mat & 6X24" ruler

Thread to match bias trim and main fabrics

Marking pencil to contrast with main fabric and lining

22" zipper or zipper tape (recommended) to coordinate with main fabric

1/4" piecing foot and edge stitch (Bernina), or Viking left edge topstitch foot or edge joining foot (works best)

1 yd belting and safety pin (optional)

Freezer paper or interfacing for tracing pattern

Pattern

Fabric and supplies: as listed on pattern, including both fusible fleece and fusible foam. I used woven fusible for the Pellon906 listed on the pattern. And also substituted it for the décor bond when using linen on the pockets. If using cotton quilting fabric for the pockets, use décor bond as pattern requests.

HOMEWORK FOR MIDTOWN BAG

- Trace all pattern pieces per size of purse you are making
- Per pattern cutting chart, cut all pieces per your choice of bag size, including the bias trim.
- Be sure to label as you cut
- Prepare the bias trim by sewing strips together and using the fold and press instructions on page 2 per figures 10, 11, and 12
- Fuse the fusible fleece to your 2 outside main pieces
- Fuse the Bosal (soft and Stable) to the lining fabric

(If you are not comfortable doing the fusing, just wait till class.)
